EMPLOYERS CIRCULAR NO. 14/2011

REMINDER ON THE EXPIRY DATE OF SUBMISSION OF TRAINING GRANT CLAIMS UNDER THE 1MALAYSIA TRAINING PROGRAMME

1.0 PURPOSE

- 1.1 The purpose of this circular is to remind employers on the expiry date of submission of training grant claims under 1Malaysia Training Programme i.e. **31 December 2011**.

2.0 BACKGROUND

- 2.1 On 6 April 2011, PSMB implemented the 1Malaysia Training Programme with an allocation of RM200 million. The fund was allocated during the tabling of the 2011 Budget and to be utilised by employers for up-skilling and reskilling of employees before 31 December 2011. Under the programme, the Government would finance and credit 20% of the course fee into employers' accounts after the completion of training. A total of 403 training providers participated under the programme involving 4,979 courses.
- 2.2 Training programmes that are eligible for the incentive are courses approved under the 1Malaysia Training Programme and any courses classified as upskilling and re-skilling programme under SBL

Scheme, SBL-Khas Scheme, PROLUS Scheme and PERLA Scheme.

3.0 **REMINDER**

3.1 Employers are advised to send their training grant claims under the 1Malaysia Training Programme, SBL Scheme, SBL-Khas Scheme, PROLUS Scheme and PERLA Scheme **before or on 31 December 2011**. Any submissions after 31 December 2011 will not be eligible for the 20% incentives.
