TRAINING PROVIDERS CIRCULAR NO. 3/2013

INELIGIBILITY OF EMPLOYERS PLACED UNDER LIQUIDATION OR WINDING UP TO RECEIVE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE OR OTHER BENEFIT UNDER HRDF

1.0 PURPOSE

- 1.1 The purpose of this circular is to inform training providers regarding the ineligibility of employers placed under liquidation or winding up under Companies Act, 1965 to receive any financial assistance or other benefit provided under the Human Resources Development Fund (HRDF).

2.0 BACKGROUND

- 2.1 Pembangunan Sumber Manusia Berhad (PSMB) faced problems disbursing claims of training providers for employers who had been placed under liquidation or winding up. This is due to the fact that employers placed under liquidation or winding up have no employees and had ceased operation.
- 2.2 In pursuant to PSMB Act 2001, employers who are placed under liquidation or winding up shall be disqualified from receiving such financial assistance or other benefit under HRDF and shall be deregistered as registered employers with PSMB.
- 2.3 Training providers are advise to check the status of employers before offering their training programmes. It is training providers' responsibility

to ensure that employers they are engaging with are not placed under both categories. This is to avoid their claims being rejected by PSMB.
